RAIDER RUN

- Raider Run is a 5k race through the HA neighborhood. A one mile fun-run is also available for participants not interested in the 5k. We appreciate any amount of time you can offer as a volunteer. We especially need volunteers the day of our race, which will include a set-up team, race time team, and clean up team. If you can provide more time to the group beyond race day, we will start meeting when school begins and will meet as needed. If you are unable to attend meetings, but would still like to help, you will be kept up to date via email and can help from home. RAIDER RETAIL

Four volunteers are needed per day, but shifts are divided so that 2-3 volunteers work at a time. MAY FAIR

- May Fair is an annual festival held on campus geared towards LS and MS students. It is
 usually the first Thursday of May each year during the school day, rain or shine.
- May Fair is PTO's largest fundraiser and highly anticipated by our students each year. There are a wide variety of activities including games, rides, face painting, inflatables, train rides, bingo, cakewalk, and a bake sale. Refreshments are also provided. Parent volunteers of lower school and middle school classrooms work shifts along with MS volunteer students to supervise the various activities, sell refreshments, and provide baked goods for the bake sale. Parent volunteers help organize the event, work booths, and help secure event sponsors to raise funds for PTO. Funds are also raised by selling Mayfair wristbands, t-shirts, and bake sale items.

- Lower school lunchroom coordinator is charged with organizing parents/grandparents of children in grades 1-4 who would like to volunteer during Lower School lunchtime.

FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY

• This program gives parents a chance to buy a new book for our library in honor of their child's birthday. A sign-up sheet will go home at the beginning of the school year. On the child's birthday, they will have the opportunity to choose their birthday book, and a sticker will be placed on the inside cover of the book recognizing your child. The volunteer in charge of FoL sends home book sheets, organizes returned forms and money.

SPIRIT CARDS

• The sale of spirit cards helps to raise money for our school. Spirit cards have participating businesses listed that offer discounts or free services when you use their business and present your card. Information on how to purchase/sell the cards and participating businesses will be sent home as soon as they are available. Volunteers help sell spirit cards at HA and in the community.
