In Honors Studio Art you will be asked to determine a concentration idea for the year. It can be as simple as a study of shadows or a view of your SOLE (working with feet and shoes) – whatever you choose there should be a common thread throughout your work. Start brainstorming! Make it personal or at least something that interests you or that you are truly passionate about! At the beginning of school be ready to talk through at least 10 ideas for a common thread through your work this year. We will narrow down your ideas from the 10 to have a more concrete idea of your journey through art in 2022/2023! I am Excited!!

Complete 2 pieces of Art this summer- they can be the medium of your choice, but use 2 different mediums. (Pencil, colored pencil, pen, water color, acrylic)

Both pieces should be 9x12 or larger.

1 – Your first piece should be of a metallic object or a reflective surface: zero in on a section of the reflective object – for example a close up of part of a bike, spoon, car bumper, coffee pot etc... Use all of your paper and show the surrounding items that are reflected in the metallic part as well as the background. Create a composition using details and shadows, lights and darks. This will take time – TAKE YOUR TIME! Anything worthwhile takes time-



2- Create a piece showing FORESHORTENING – if you are unsure what this means – look it up. Use your phone to take a picture and work from the picture you have taken. Put sincere thought into your subject matter!!!!
